HOW TO READ THE SPLIT HEXAGRAM SPREAD

• Take note of your first impressions, preponderances, and obvious patterns.

- Card 1: Theme. This card suggests a general overview of the situation.
- Cards 1 and 2: The spiritual influences. Card 2 has stronger or more immediate relevance than Card 1. These cards represent the big picture. They can indicate the external forces at work, or can indicate the emotional or psychological state of the querent. In relationship readings, these three cards often represent one person/party in the partnership.
- Card 3: The spiritual advice. This is the quality that can help you realize or appease the external forces.
- Cards 4 and 5: The practical concerns. Card 5 is stronger than Card 4. These cards indicate things you have control over or steps you can take to achieve the desired outcome. In a relationship or partnership spread, these cards might represent one of the two people/parties involved.
- Card 6: The practical advice. This is the action you can pursue or problem you must face to achieve the desired outcome.
- Card 7: Final outcome or next step. This card represents the resolution of the situation or the next goal that must be achieved before continuing toward the desired outcome.
- Cards 1 and 4: The past.
- Cards 2 and 5: The future.
- Cards 1 and 5: The practical conflict in the situation.
- Cards 4 and 2: The spiritual or emotional conflict in the situation.
- Cards 3 and 6: The best approach to resolve or achieve the situation.
